 In the sentence above, there is an error in the spelling of the standard word "Aktifitas."
 According to the Big Indonesian Dictionary, the correct spelling is "Aktivitas."
- 3. Because my younger sibling ate too many candies, they started coughing, so my mother went to the pharmacy because the cough medicine for my sibling had run out.
 In the sentence above, there is an error in the spelling of the standard word Apotik. According to the Kamus Besar Bahasa Indonesia (Great Dictionary of the Indonesian Language), the word should be spelled Apotek (Sakrim, 2017).

Then, in applying language editing to improve language comprehension, the Scramble Method can be used for children's games that develop and improve vocabulary knowledge. Scramble consists of various types of forms, namely Word Scramble, which is a game of arranging scrambled letters or words to form a specific meaningful word; for example, Alpajera becomes Pelajar (student). Scramble Sentences is a game of arranging random words into sentences that are logical, meaningful, accurate, and correct. Scramble Discourse is a game of arranging logical discourse based on random sentences. The resulting discourse arrangement should be logical and meaningful (Tanjung et al., 2021). Thus, language editing is critical in helping students expand their vocabulary and understanding. With good language editing, students can learn from their mistakes and improve their language skills.

C. Helping students understand the connection between vocabulary and meaning
